

COMMISSION ADDENDUM

Effective from January 2005

1. SPECIALIST BROKERS

We pay 15% commission for this Broker status. To qualify for Specialist Broker status please see Section 3 of the Terms of Business Agreement ("TOBA").

Specialist Brokers are rewarded at a higher level than General Brokers because we wish them to invest in the resources needed to develop New Business for us and provide the highest quality of service to Policyholders/Clients. We expect that the investment in resources will result in growth of the existing Broker Euler Hermes UK and Euler Hermes Ireland portfolios (as applicable), by the renewal of existing business and the development of New Business.

2. PREMIUMS NET OF BROKERAGE

If it is agreed between the Policyholder/Client and us that they will pay premium under the Policy net of brokerage/commission then no commission will be payable to you under the TOBA.

3. OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

From time to time we may agree with you alternative arrangements under which you will be remunerated for your brokerage services. These arrangements will apply by way of amendment to the TOBA and will only be effective if agreed by you and us in writing.

All other conditions of the TOBA apply as stated.
